Texas Tech University is pleased to host the Spring Meet Contests of the University Interscholastic League, Region 1, Conference 3A & 5A. It is our privilege to assist the public schools in having superior meets.

A successful meet depends, in part, upon the prompt filing, payment and reporting of contest entries. It is the responsibility of the District Director to file and submit payment for the Region 1 – 3A & 5A Spring Meet Contests.

Filing Deadlines:

- A. Academic entries, including Academic Team points for wild card consideration, must be reported to the Regional Director by 5 p.m. Monday following the individual District Meet. District results are received using the UIL Spring Meet online system. The district director must personally ensure entry reports are certified online.
- B. Athletic entries due to Regional personnel immediately following district meets; but no later than:
 - Golf Noon, Monday, following District Competition
 - Track & Field Noon, Wednesday, following District Competition
 - Tennis Noon, Monday, following District Competition
- C. District directors may have to personally deliver, fax, email, or telephone entries to meet deadlines. If district contests are conducted at sites other than the district director's home school, the director should personally ensure entry reports reach the Regional office.

Alternate Qualifiers/Substitutions:

- A. Alternates must qualify as per the UIL regulations governing an individual contest.
- B. **ACADEMIC SUBSTITUTIONS:** The local school official must notify the District Meet Director of all substitutions. Substitutions are reported to the Regional site by faxing the official "UIL Academic Contest Substitute Eligibility Form" found on page 163 of the UIL Spring Meet Manual and/or on the UIL website to Lynn Elms, 806-742-1660, or the form maybe hand delivered to tournament officials prior to competition.

3A & 5A District Director Fee Schedule:

The District Director for each district represented in Conference 3A & 5A Region 1 shall send one check for the total amount of entry fees from the district. The District Director may assess each member school according to the number of contestants qualified.

3A & 5A District Spring Meet Fee: \$4,756 (*plus a One Act Play additional fee*)

Individual schools qualifying from Area to Region in One Act Play must provide a \$300 One Act Play fee to the Regional Contest Director prior to performance.

Schools entering Computer Applications, Computer Science & Number Sense participants are required to provide one grader for each event.

Please note the golf medalist fee is now included in the District Director fees.
